Information on Rubbish Pickup

Bulk Collection Pilot Program

May 1, 2026, Manatee County Utilities launched the Bulk Collection Pilot Program for Unincorporated Manatee County residential solid waste customers, expanding curbside bulk collection service. Residents may place up to two bulk items at the curb once per month on their scheduled collection day, for up to 12 pickups per year. Tires, appliances and the annual bulk pickup must be scheduled in advance through the Customer Self-Service Portal at www.mymanatee.org/css.

Manatee County's Medical Waiver (Rear Door Assistance) Program: Making Waste Disposal Accessible for All

Manatee County's Medical Rear Door Assistance Program offers curbside garbage bin collection and return for residents with mobility-limiting conditions. Eligibility requires physician certification and application through the Solid

Waste Division. Once approved, sanitation workers manage bin placement and retrieval on collection days. The service supports independence and is provided at no additional cost beyond the standard monthly rate.

Recycle Different Materials Together

Manatee County uses single-stream recycling, allowing all clean recyclable paper, flattened cardboard, cans, glass, and plastics to be placed together in one cart for easy curbside collection.
