Hotwire Migration Update # 5 May 11, 2022

Outside Potential for an accidental disruption of Service

Hotwire Communications is beginning construction today [Wednesday] and will be placing fiber runs from the source by the SR70 gate along 87th Street East and then terminating at the location of their equipment hut, near the Highlands Circle.

With any project involving digging, as with this one, all utilities (electric, gas, water, cable etc.) are requested to mark the location of their buried facilities. Though all other utilities have done so, Spectrum has not provided markings showing where its infrastructure is installed. Hotwire had delayed construction for two weeks waiting for Spectrum to mark their lines and they has still not done so. Spectrum may not know where their wires are buried – the infrastructure was installed by Brighthouse prior to being acquired by Spectrum – or may have chosen not to take action.

The problems is that without knowing where the Spectrum lines are laid, no matter how careful Hotwire is, there is always potential to accidently hit a line and cut it.

Bottom line, we want you to be aware that there is an outside chance that Hotwire could cut a Spectrum line causing some residents to be without service. If this were to happen, Hotwire would do everything they can to quickly repair the break and get the cable service back up

and running, though they are prohibited from making repairs to Spectrum cables.

Should a line accidently be cut causing an outage to occur, please contact Lindsey Mankin of Hotwire at 954/829-2246 to arrange for a quick repair.
